She is also a guest blogger for *Experience Life Magazine*.

Marilee is an adjunct professor at American University's School of Public Affairs in their Key Executive Leadership Program, a member of the Core Faculty, Certificates in Leadership Coaching, cosponsored by Adler International Learning and the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education of the University Toronto.
